## YOU DID IT!

### Hey parents!

Last week we learned about Jesus' first miracle. He continued to perform miracles and more people in Jerusalem began to believe in Him. Many others still didn't know what to believe. There was a man named Nicodemus, who heard Jesus speak and saw His miracles and wanted to know more. He went looking to find Jesus and asked how he could see the Kingdom of God (heaven). It was during this conversation, Jesus told Nicodemus we need to believe in Jesus in order to go to heaven. Jesus is the one and only way to heaven (John 14:6).

### Take the Family Challenge

## THINK RIGHT 2 Peter 3:18a (Top 12)

**“But grow in the grace** (raise up from a squatting position and raise hands up to sky) **and knowledge** (point to your head) **of our Lord** (point up) **and Savior** (other pointer finger up) **Jesus Christ** (point to the palm of each hand).” 2 Peter 3:18a

Parents, hide green items (toy cars, balls, crayons, small pieces of crumpled green paper, etc.) in your playroom or living room. The color green helps us remember to grow! Have your kids find the green items and place them in a bucket.

When they find a green item, have them recite 2 Peter 3:18a. Challenge your kids to grow closer to Jesus and learn about heaven by listening to you read your Bible to them. Remind them that Jesus is the only one who can save us from our sin, and when we believe in Him, He promises that we will be with Him in heaven someday.

*Note: Often kids fear, if they believe in Jesus, they will go to heaven immediately. Take time to explain God has a purpose for our lives here on earth, as well as in heaven.*
